In 1993, he became an Associate Professor of Pediatric Cardiology, Heart Institute of Japan, Tokyo Women's Medical College. Since 1988, he is a chief of Pediatric Interventional Catheterization Laboratory at Heart Institute of Japan, Tokyo Women's Medical University. Since 2007, he is a chief of the Department of Pediatric Cardiology, Tokyo Women's Medical University, Tokyo, Japan. Since 2009, He is a President of Japanese Society of Pediatric Cardiology and Cardiac Surgery.
